**NEW MEMBERS:** If you have never registered a skater in one of our programs before, make sure to create an account profile

- You will need to create a Parent profile and then add each participant/skater
- Please leave Instructor field blank
- Please add in your child's Skate Canada number if you have one

**RETURNING MEMBERS:** Login to the website by clicking on the "Login" button at the top right corner. If you can't remember your login or password, please email the registrar and she will reset it for you: [registrar@tgiceskatingclub.com](mailto:registrar@tgiceskatingclub.com)

- **For StarSkate, be sure of what program you're registering for. You will receive an email with your skaters' program recommendation. If you are not sure, please email us at [coaches@tgiceskatingclub.com](mailto:coaches@tgiceskatingclub.com) before proceeding.**
- **STARSkate & CompetitiveSkate:** Make sure to read the "Volunteer & Fundraising Requirements for 2022/2023" (link found on home page). \*Each STARSkate family is responsible for selecting 400 volunteer credits. If you have not completed your volunteer commitment by Jun 1, 2023 you will be charged \$400. Families will have a buy out option.
- If you are registering a skater for **Pre-CanSkate**, please note the following pre-requisites:
  - Basic listening capabilities and ability to follow instructions at a level typical for a 3 to 5-year-old child.
  - Demonstrates the ability to respect authority figures.
  - As parents are NOT ALLOWED on the ice, your child must feel comfortable about being away from mom/dad for 30 mins, having experience in a daycare/day home/playschool may help.
- Please make sure to fill in the comments section during the registration process to identify any special needs, allergies or other valuable information. This is especially important for the younger skaters.

## AVAILABLE DISCOUNTS!

- **EARLY BIRD DISCOUNT!** - Register by August 1, 2022 and save an additional 5% off your invoice
- **THE MORE YOU SKATE, THE MORE YOU CAN SAVE!**

- Pre-CanSkate, CanSkate, Intro to FS - Register for any 3 days/skater and receive 15% off!
- Jr. & Preliminary StarSkate - Register for 2 days/week and receive 10% off!
  - Register for 3-4 days/week and receive 15%!
- Int. & Senior StarSkate - Register for 3 days/week and receive 10% off!
  - Register for 4 days/week and receive 15% off!

*\* Discounts only apply per skater.*

*\* Discounts only apply to program fees; discounts do not apply to the Skate Canada fee and invoice processing fee.*

*\* Multi-Day discounts will be applied to your program fees first and then if applicable the early bird discount will be applied.*

*\* Discounts will not be retroactive. Any applicable discounts to new programs added will apply to only the new programs. (For example, if you register for 2 days of CanSkate in the fall and then later decide to register for 1 day in the winter your discount would only apply to the 1 day that was added.)*

To reduce your program fees further, you may choose to work bingos at the Thorncliffe Greenview Community Association (see link on the Important resources page: “TGCA Fee Assistance Initiative Information”). TGISC gets a limited number of bingos and they are offered on a first come, first serve basis.

## IMPORTANT PAYMENT INFORMATION

### **1. IF YOU CHOOSE TO WORK BINGOS YOU MUST PICK THE PAYMENT OPTION TO "PAY IN PERSON"**

The TGISC registrar will contact you to confirm the number of bingos you wish to work, decrease your invoice by the subsidized amount, and then you may pay with a credit card or e-transfer (see below). This is done by clicking “Log in” at the top, right corner of the screen at [www.tgiceskatingclub.com](http://www.tgiceskatingclub.com).

**Note** - The Skate Canada fee and Invoice Processing & Administration fee are not payable by bingos.

### **2. IF YOU CHOOSE NOT TO WORK BINGOS, YOU CAN PAY BY:**

- CREDIT CARD: Pick the payment option "PAY BY CREDIT CARD".

- E-TRANSFER: Pick the payment option “PAY IN PERSON” and send your e-transfer to [treasurer@tgiceskatingclub.com](mailto:treasurer@tgiceskatingclub.com). Make sure to note in the transfer what and who the payment is for, as well as the invoice number.

**New for STARSKATE only!** – You have the option to Pay in Full or by Instalments. You will see this option as a dropdown option upon checkout.
