**VOLUNTEER & FUNDRAISING REQUIREMENTS 2021/2022 Season**  
*For Junior, Preliminary, Intermediate and Senior STARSkate & CompetitiveSkate*

*The Thorncliffe Greenview Ice Skating Club is run entirely by volunteers.  
Our Club is growing and in order to meet its many needs, we require many volunteers.*

As in the past, STARSkate families will still be required to volunteer in some capacity. This year, each family will be responsible for accumulating 400 volunteer credits. We have come up with a list of volunteer roles and responsibilities and have assigned a credit value to each one. During the registration process you will be asked to select enough volunteer roles so that you have 400 credits. You will not be able to complete your registration unless you have selected enough volunteer credits.

**\$400 charge will be held on your account as a volunteer deposit.** On June 1, 2022 we will assess if you have accumulated enough credits in order to meet your volunteer commitment. At that time if your commitment has been honoured then we will, remove the charge. If not, the charge will be put through. You do have the option to “buy-out” your Volunteer commitment for \$400. If you wish to pursue this option, \$400 will be added to your cart at the time of your online registration.

The general categories for volunteer positions are: Executive, Organizers and Helpers, Maintenance/Organization, Communication, COVID Return to Play Protocol Committee (if needed), and Miscellaneous. Each role will have a general description on our website. There will also be direction and additional information provided to you, so even if you don't feel you know enough to take on a certain role, we can help you.
